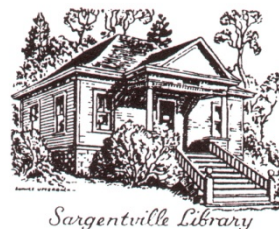

This independent press, founded and run by Bill Henderson, operates from a small shop in the heart of Sedgwick village. On a gorgeous day approximately sixty people attended the reception held from 5 to 7 P.M. at the Sargentville home of Rada and Rob Starkey. Bill graciously donated all the proceeds from book sales to the library.

Another special event occurred in July when we collaborated with the Sedgwick-Brooklin Historical Society to keep the library open during the *Touring Through Time* event.
