GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Sedgwick, in said County, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Sedgwick Town Office, in said Town, at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, the 12th day of December, 2024, then and there to act on the following articles:

- 1. To choose a moderator to preside over said meeting.
- 2. To see if the town will vote to change the Town Clerk position from elected to appointed, with a term of one year, said change to be effective at the 2025 annual town meeting.
- 3. To see if the Town will vote to change the Town Treasurer position from elected to appointed with a term of one year, said change to be effective at the 2026 annual town meeting.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to change the Road Commissioner position from elected to appointed with a term of one year, said change to be effective at the 2026 annual town meeting.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to approve the purchase agreement for a new Fire Truck for the Fire Department, not to exceed \$408,000.00 for delivery in 2028.
- 6. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen, on behalf of the Town, to join with other participating municipal and quasi-municipal employers in a Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement for the provision of employee health benefits, as authorized by 24-A M.R.S.A. § 6601 et seq., said Arrangement to be known as the "Maine Municipal Employees Health Trust" (Health Trust); and for that purpose and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements among participating employers, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a Participation Agreement on behalf of the Town and take whatever other actions may be necessary. The authority granted herein shall continue until revoked.
